Courtney Fate was a senior at Purdue University in September 2008, well on her way to graduating with an industrial engineering degree, when doctors diagnosed her with a rare and aggressive form of colon cancer. Though her prognosis was not favorable, she never wavered in her desire to meet head-on the personal goals she had set out to achieve and the challenges brought on by this bleak diagnosis. Her family and friends swelled with pride as she received her diploma in May 2009. Though she passed away on January 30, 2010, just 15 days past her 24th birthday, it is hoped that her spirit will live on through the Courtney Fate Engineering Scholarship established by her family (grandparents Fred and Janice Wendt) and friends (Eric Hammond, Matthew Dudeck, Nicole Moorhead, and Judith Hollis).
